Mr. William Tong, the Chairman of the Federation of the Hong Kong Polytechnic University Alumni Associations congratulated the successful functions organized by HKPEEEAA and encouraged more active development of alumni activities

Mr. Raymond Woo explained that HKPEEEAA was very active in the past and was one of the top 3 active alumni associations in the Polytechnic in the seventy and eighty. ## A BRIEF HISTORY OF HKP EEEAA

The existing HKPEEEAA is currently found in the Hong Kong Polytechnic University Alumni Homepage: [http://www.polyu.edu.hk/aado/alumni/main\\_associationd.htm](http://www.polyu.edu.hk/aado/alumni/main_associationd.htm). The HKPEEEAA was, in fact, evolved from the Hong Kong Technical College Electrical Engineering Alumni Association (HKTCEEAA) established in 1965. The founders were probably Mr. PUN Kwok Wah and Mr. LAM Shiu Lau. With the establishment of the Hong Kong Polytechnic, the Alumni Association was renamed as HK Polytechnic Electrical and Electronic Engineering Alumni Association. At that time, the Alumni covered two departments, the Electrical Engineering Department and Electronic Engineering Department. Dr LH

Lees and Dr Joshua Wong were the Honorary Advisors of the Alumni Association.

Around 1974, Mr. Raymond Woo was elected and joined the HKPEEEAA Executive Committee. Since then, over these nearly 30 years, Raymond, together with other committee members had contributed quite a lot in providing various activities for both members and students related to the Hong Kong Polytechnic. They were on voluntary basis to serve. The number of members in HKPEEEAA was maintained at 800 during the period of 1970 to 1980 and was the one of the top three Alumni in the Hong Kong Polytechnic.
