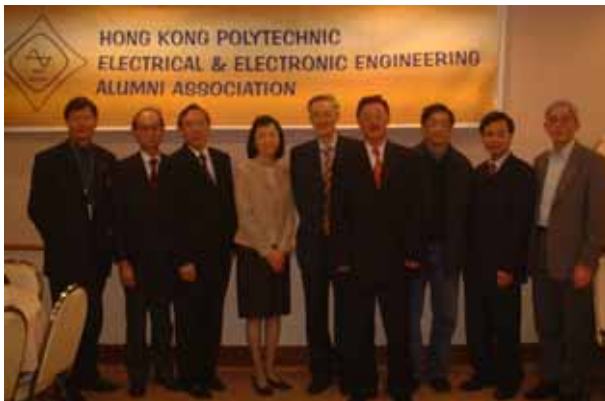

THE HONG KONG TECHNICAL COLLEGE ELECTRICAL & ELECTRONIC ENGINEERING ASSOCIATION

In 1966 our Principal Mr. Sung announced to split the Students' Union into Departmental Associations and each Association selects a committee member to join together to form the Office Bearers in the Student's Union, thus keeping the Union to handle all the affairs of the Hong Kong Technical College and each Association to handle its own affairs, so that the Association concerned may promote close friendship and exchange experience between its own members.

When we first started to organise our Association, we had difficulties in getting the names and address of the past students. Thanks to the efforts by our Department Head Mr. C.L. Leung and Mr. C.S. Leung in helping us to gather those students together to form the Preparatory Committee. We had spent nine months in persuading the past students to become members of our Association, and to draw up the constitution to let the members have a clear idea of what kind of work our Association will do for our fellow members. Finally, in September, 1966 our First General Meeting was held at Keswick Hall of Hong Kong Technical College, Mr. C. K. Lam was elected as the Hon. Chairman, Mr. K.W. Pun the Hon. Secretary and Mr. S. O. Chau the Hon. Treasurer. During the 1st year we had about six lectures on Electrical & Electronic field and two outdoor activities, namely, a picnic and a launch picnic. In the Second General Meeting, the Office Bearers experienced that one Secretary was not enough to handle the work and \$5.00 subscription fee was not enough for the expenditure for the activities, and the Associate Membership was introduced for the students who studied (studying) in our Department without being awarded a Diploma or a Certificate. We add this because we found out that it is unfair not to accept those students who hope to join our Association. So we revised our constitution to add an Assistant Hon. Secretary, an Associate Membership and to raise the subscription fee from \$5.00 to \$10.00 for Full Members and \$5.00 for Associate Members. All the members are assured to have the same benefits from the Association. In this meeting Mr. S.H. Wen was elected as the Chairman, Mr. S.L. Lam the Hon. Secretary Mr. Charles S.P. Lee the Assistant Hon. Secretary and Mr. S. Ho the Hon. Treasurer. In the second year we had visited a T.V. manufacturing factory, the H.K. Television Broadcast Co. Ltd., picnics and an Annual Ball. Owing to the unavailability of time for the committee to organize, the Third General Meeting was delayed; yet all our committee members still tried their best to organize some lectures on Logic & Telemetry Control and Super-conductivity for all our fellow members.

Finally, I have to assure you that our Association is anxious to welcome all the graduates from our Electrical Engineering Department of the Hong Kong Technical College as Members and those who are still studying as Associate Members. We also hope to receive comments from all of our Members in order to help us to make improvements.
